

Embracing Diversity

Next time you are attending worship, small group, or another event at Chester UMC, look around. We've made great strides in looking more like Heaven! In the pews are voices not only with Virginia accents, but those from around the globe. The Sunday we introduced "You are Safe with Me" pins, there were men and women beaming with smiles and with tears running down their cheeks because they never imagined being welcomed, included, and affirmed as a child of God. Soccer & prayer with kids & youth, Spanish language women's Bible study, and food distribution in Greenleigh – these are ways Chester UMC is caring for and making Latino disciples. Gracias a Dios!

Loving Children and Families

"All of my kids can't wait to do this next year!" This is a commonly heard theme around our ministries with kids at Chester UMC. Whether it's playing at the park, making a communion banner, or singing songs at VBS: we know how to share Jesus' love with the little children. We have VBS volunteers who share the gospel with little disciples, Trunk or Treat that introduces community kids to our church, and the assurance of being loved and safe in our nursery. We've also rebooted our acolyte ministry in worship at our Fresh Start service. Sunday School has gone from one class to two classes! God continues to bless our church with new faces, many of whom have little hands of their own.

Positively Impacting Our Community

We Build Community. We partnered with Schools, Greenleigh, Local Law Enforcement, Fire Stations 1 and 14, the Chamber of Commerce, the YMCA; and our agenda is always the same: we build community. From playing at the park to picking up trash around Ecoff to writing notes and cards to veterans, we make the world a little brighter and a little less cold by sharing the love we have received.
