Backpack Ministry Update: CUMC continues to bless, out of our abundance, those children facing food insecurity from Curtis and CC Wells Elementary Schools. Historically, we have provided about 50 bags of food each weekend (each bag is designed to feed two children). We include mostly shelf-stable, nonperishable items. These bags provide more than just food – they provide care, love, and support. You can support this ministry by your donations of items needed i.e., canned chicken, canned tuna, Spam, plastic jars of jelly, boxes/pouches of potatoes (mashed, scalloped, au gratin, etc.) peanut butter, canned pasta (like ravioli), soup, boxed mac & cheese, applesauce cups, tuna helper, Knorr rice sides (5.7 oz size), toaster pastries, oatmeal, fruit chews, and peanut butter crackers. Donations may be left in the labeled bin in the Missions Closet or on the screened porch on the left side of The Cottage. You may text Karen Comer (804-683-5645) to let her know you left items for the Backpacks. Monetary donations are welcomed as well! Make checks payable to CUMC (Memo: Backpack). Carolyn Landis has accepted a full-time position this year, so the Jean Craig Fellowship is assisting by delivering the bags of food to the schools each week. Thank you to all who contribute time, donations, and food items in support of this vital ministry.
