<u>Today We Celebrate Aldersgate Day (Heritage Sunday)</u>. You will find a display of some Chester UMC artifacts in the atrium and also in the display cabinet in the narthex. The History Committee has spent countless hours transferring documents and photographs into an acid-free environment so that we can enjoy them for years to come.

There are 11 scrapbooks on the round table in the atrium to investigate and remember days gone by! The more current documents that you found in *A Community in Christ, Chester United Methodist Church*, are digital so they have not been printed.

Aldersgate Day/Heritage Sunday is set aside specifically for remembering our legacy as United Methodists. This Day calls the Church to remember the past by committing itself to the continuing call of God.

Both the Altar and Pulpit from the 1891 Chester Methodist Episcopal Church South are displayed in the narthex. The Pulpit still wears the original wax drippings from candles (since this was used before electricity). Both Altar and Pulpit were used in the 1927 Sanctuary until we built the 1973 Sanctuary when new furnishings were given.
