

### **EASTER EGGS AND FINDING JESUS**

"A great accomplishment shouldn't be the end of the road, just the starting point for the next leap forward."- Harvey Mackay

What's the big deal about Easter? Chocolate bunnies, Cadbury delights, and egg hunts are all of my childhood memories. Recently, I've learned there is another meaning for the term *Easter Eggs*. In the Marvel Comic Movies, from <u>Captain America</u> and <u>the Avengers</u> to <u>Ant Man</u> and

the <u>Guardians of the Galaxy</u>, the movie 'hides' a clip at the end of the movie or within the credits that gives you a sneak peek at the next installment in the Marvel Movies. Other times, they'll add things to the movie that only those who have seen the other sixteen movies will understand. In the Movie Industry, they have come to call these *Easter Eggs*. My two boys and I love them. At the movie theatre, we sit impatiently on the edge of our seats through the entire credits just to *find* one of these Eggs. When we rent a movie, we quickly hit fast forward to scroll through all the names of the people involved in making the movie so that we can *catch a glimpse* of the future movie that will satisfy our need for entertainment and story.

Finding... Catching a glimpse... Being surprised...

For disciples of Jesus Christ, Easter morning is more like the Easter Eggs in the movies than the ones we search for on our front lawn. The early disciples go to the tomb on Easter morning to grieve the loss of a savior, a rabbi, and their friend. Instead of grief at the grave, they discover the surprise that they are now involved in a "where's Jesus" moment (yes, think "where's Waldo")... Jesus is supposed to be dead. The movement of God is supposed to be dead. They were going to put flowers down at the grave and then go back to fishing. This is how life and death work – no surprises. When they *find* Jesus they *catch a glimpse* of resurrection, eternal life, and the Kingdom of God. They are surprised.

Faith is intended to be a surprise. Following Christ leads to empty tombs and Easter Eggs like those in the movies. Finding Jesus means catching a glimpse of the exciting future God has in store for us as the Church. Experts and futurists are moaning and groaning about the death of the Church in the US. The movement of God on these shores seems to be dead. We seem to be in grief. However, if we are going to be disciples of Jesus, we should be looking for a surprise.

For us as disciples of Jesus Christ, Easter is not a celebration of a past event, but instead is all about the future. Our faith is not a faith of the past. Easter is not a visit to the grave but an encounter with God's resurrection power. Easter is the single most important day/season in the church. For Seven Sundays we intentionally are reminded about the surprise that Jesus didn't stay dead. We *find* Christ not in the tomb, but in the world – still working for the Kingdom to come fully here. We *catch a glimpse* at what disciples, the church, and God are going to be about – resurrection, eternal life, Kingdom-time! God's not done yet. God has conquered the grave!

Unlike my boys and me, we don't need to fast-forward to these moments. Our life always seems to be in fast-forward mode. We need to slow down. God calls us to slow down. Mary, stop weeping at the grave. The couple on the road to Emmaus, stop debating what you have heard. Thomas, doubt no more. Peter, realize that you've been forgiven and charged with leading the church. Disciple, do not be afraid. Jesus is with us. Christ is risen! God is giving us a sneak peek at what's in store for us in the future. That's the big deal about Easter.


