UMCOR Kits for Conference: The United Methodist Committee on Relief operates two relief depots, one in Salt Lake City and the Sager Brown Depot in Baldwin, Louisiana. For the past several years CUMC and the UMW have collected materials for and assembled hygiene kits to be sent to Sager Brown. They collect kits to have on hand when disaster strikes. Due to tornadoes and flooding in the Southeast and war in Eastern Europe and the Near East there is an urgent need to restock their inventory of hygiene kits.
